



How to Create a Project Tree

Steps	Description	Example Functions
<p>[1-4] In Datamaker, go to Project Manager, right-click the Projects, and click the New Project and Version option.</p> <p>In the Create Project dialog, specify the project and version names and descriptions. Click the Save Details button and OK on the subsequent dialogs.</p>	<p>This assumes that you have already launched Datamaker, logged onto and connected to the Profile mapped to the Test Data Repository.</p>	<p>The first screenshot shows the 'Projects' tree in Datamaker. <p>[12-14] Click Yes on the Create new Data Pool dialog.</p> <p>In the New Data Pool dialog, specify the data set name and description. Click the Save Details button and OK on the New Data Pool dialog.</p>		
<p>[15-18] Now you are ready to register the Version. Right-click the version in the project list and click Register.</p> <p>Select the type of object to register and click the Go icon.</p>	<p>You must register the data definitions to Datamaker to manage the data.</p>	
<p>[19-22] Select the action you want to do on the object. Select the tables you want to register</p> <p>Click the Go icon in the Reconcile Objects to Register window. Click Yes in the Calculate Table Order dialog.</p>
